Adoptions

As the state's largest pet adoption agency, KHS is celebrating another record-setting adoptions year, with 5,238 pets placed in homes during Fiscal Year 2006-07! That's 3,898 canines (74%) and 1,340 felines (26%). One reason for this incredible success is our new reservation program, where potential adopters can pay \$25 to put their preferred pet "on hold" for 24 hours.

Feeders Supply generously allows us to make seven of their stores permanent adoption locations. Their hospitality is yet another key to our success, resulting in thousands of adoptions that may not have happened otherwise.



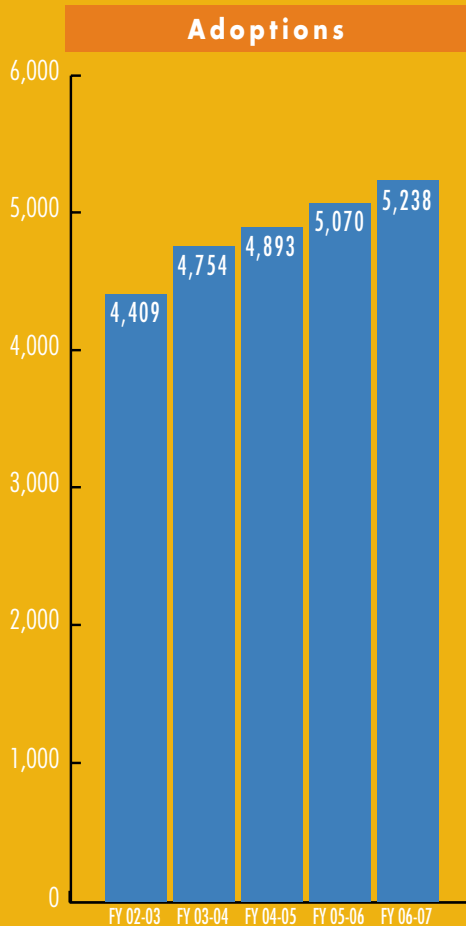
Lonely Hearts Club

KHS introduced the "Lonely Hearts Club" in 2006 to highlight pets that struggle finding permanent homes, whether it's due to special needs – such as loss of hearing or sight – or simply because they've been overlooked by adopters. This year alone, we adopted out 33 "Lonely Hearts Club" members!

Getting Back Home

In FY 06-07, we happily reunited 198 pets with their owners, in part due to microchipping, microchip scanning and our "Lost & Found" service. KHS microchips all adoptable pets and offers low-cost microchipping to owned pets at the annual **Waggin' Trail 5K**. This service gives owners an added peace of mind, ensuring that if their pet is ever lost, there is a good chance KHS can help find them again.

S.N.I.P. Clinic

Following analysis of local and national statistics that suggested adoptions alone could not solve the area's pet overpopulation crisis, KHS opened the S.N.I.P. Clinic in February 2007. By having a singular spay/neuter focus, the S.N.I.P. Clinic's high-quality, high-volume approach is unique being the only facility of its kind in the region and combating the area's pet overpopulation problem on a large scale.



This full-time public clinic is dedicated entirely to providing low-cost spay/neuter surgeries for owned pets.

In an effort to increase awareness of pet overpopulation, the S.N.I.P. Clinic launched with an attention-getting, humorous advertising campaign, encouraging individuals to spay or neuter their pets. This campaign received tremendous local and national news coverage.

During the first eight months of operation, the clinic successfully altered 3,923 owned dogs and cats.

Transport Program

In addition to providing spay/neuter services to local residents, the S.N.I.P. Clinic also introduced a free pet transport program from surrounding counties within a 90-mile radius of Louisville. Through 10 transport partners, the clinic served 1,454 companion animals in eight Kentucky counties, as well as two counties in Indiana. The S.N.I.P. Clinic also partnered with 26 animal welfare partners in the region, offering them low-cost spay/neuter surgeries for pets in their care.

Financial Aid

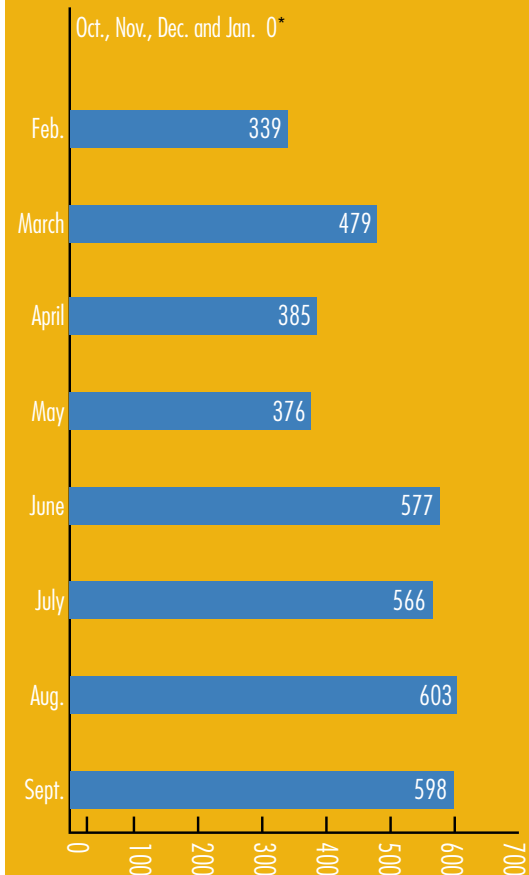
Thanks to private support, the clinic was able to provide \$5,752 in financial assistance to those who could not otherwise afford the low-cost spay/neuter services. These donations allowed us to help 47 pets and their families through our "Financial Fix" program, as well as perform 170 free pit bull surgeries.

Did You Know?

All adoptable pets are spayed or neutered, microchipped and vaccinated.

*No surgeries performed.

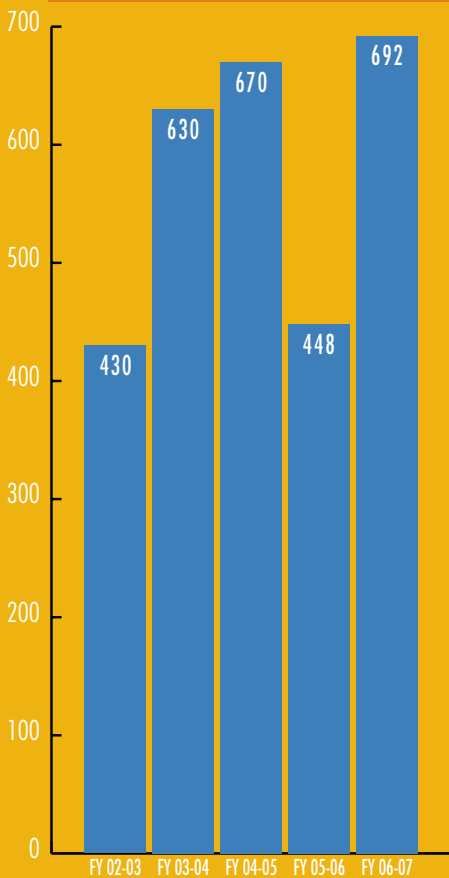

Foster Care - Pets Helped



Rescue

The KHS Rescue Department conducts rescues and handles special animal cases, including pets hit by cars, attacked by other animals, and those with life-threatening conditions and diseases. During FY 06-07, the Rescue Department cared for 51 special cases and served 91 wildlife animals.

County Rescue

Though known for our proactive programs in Jefferson County, KHS also handles animal ordinance enforcement and cruelty investigation in Henry, Spencer and Trimble Counties. This year, we helped 1,701 animals from these counties.

Safe Haven

KHS works in cooperation with the Center for Women & Families by offering assistance to domestic violence survivors through our "Safe Haven" program. While survivors receive shelter from abusive living situations, KHS cares for their pets at safe and undisclosed foster locations. In FY 06-07, KHS served six pets from three families.

Foster Care

This Fiscal Year, KHS Foster Care volunteers cared for a record number of special needs animals – 692 dogs and cats. Pets receiving help through this program include kittens and puppies too young for adoption, animals recovering from injuries, and those that just need extra socialization. KHS also utilizes emergency Foster Care volunteers during times of overcrowding.

During FY 06-07, KHS Foster Care parents volunteered 49,285 hours!

Next Generation of Pet Guardians

In 2007, KHS celebrated its 20th year of summer camp, by helping build a sense of kindness, respect and responsibility for 416 children. Thirty-eight campers participated in **Career Discovery Camp** for children 13-16 years old, and 378 children attended **Animal Adventure Camps** for those 6-12 years old. In addition, KHS also introduced a birthday party program for children 5-12 years old.

Behavior Training

Community Program

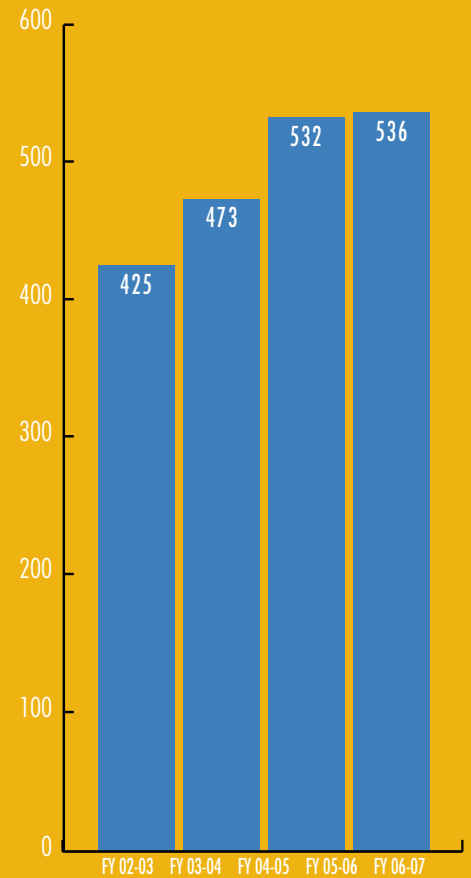
The KHS Behavior Training Program, which emphasizes education and positive training, helped 536 canine clients this Fiscal Year – a record number of participants. Through group classes, private training and behavior seminars, the KHS Behavior Training Program continues to promote lasting relationships between pets and owners. KHS also introduced new classes to increase training opportunities for pet owners. One such example is “Feisty Fido,” which is geared toward addressing canine aggression. All Behavior Training Program fees help support the KHS mission.

Shelter Training

In 2007, KHS launched “Camp Canine,” a shelter Behavior Training Program designed for canines with special behavioral needs as well as young, energetic dogs that need basic manners training prior to adoption. Through this program, canines surrendered to KHS learn basic commands, loose leash walking, polite people-greeting and more. In addition to taking home a well-behaved canine, adopters of “Camp Canine” graduates also receive a free transfer lesson as part of their adoption fee.



Behavior Training – Pets Helped

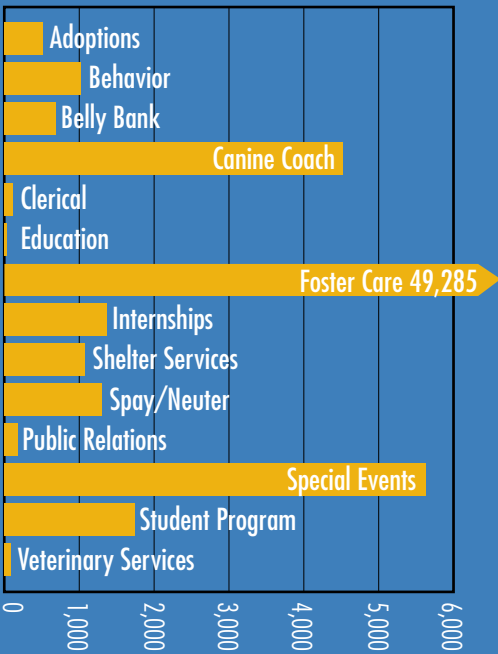


Did You Know?

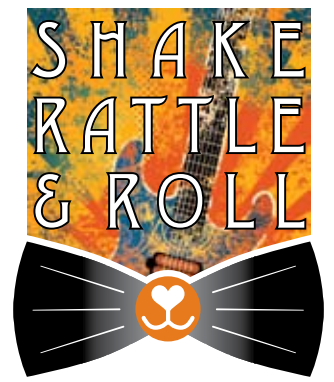
Volunteers

Thanks to the unwavering commitment and enthusiasm of KHS volunteers, we can continue caring for thousands of needy animals each year. For example, our “Canine Coach” volunteers, who help exercise and socialize adult dogs, provided walks once or twice a day during the Fiscal Year.

KHS volunteers contributed an amazing 67,535 hours in FY 06-07, up from 40,984 hours the previous Fiscal Year, primarily due to a substantial increase in foster care volunteerism!

Special Events

KHS hosts special events throughout the year to raise much-needed funds for the animals. Annual events include **Picture Your Pets With Santa**, the **Waggin’ Trail 5K, Tuxes & Tails** benefit auction and gala, **Pause For Pets** fundraising luncheon, and other promotions. Combined, these events and promotions raised more than \$649,000!

Pet Resorts

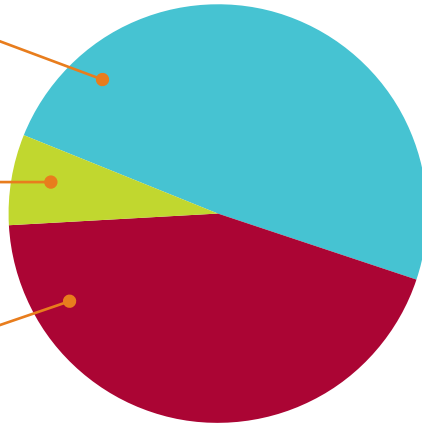
Our Eastpoint Pet Resort and Fern Creek Pet Resort were established to help support mission programs. Both pet resorts offer “Doggie Daycare,” all-breed grooming, special pet activities and boarding. New this year is “No Place Like Home” pet sitting, where KHS staff care for pets in the home while their owners are away. The KHS pet resorts served 2,655 pets in 2007.

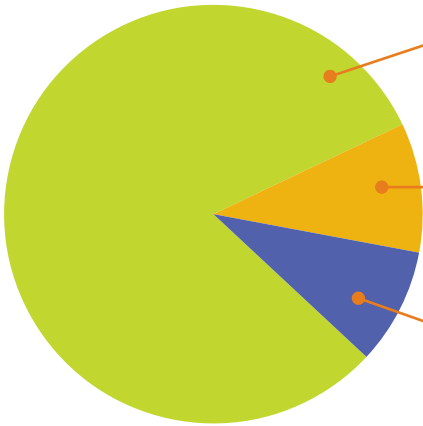


Funding Allocation
