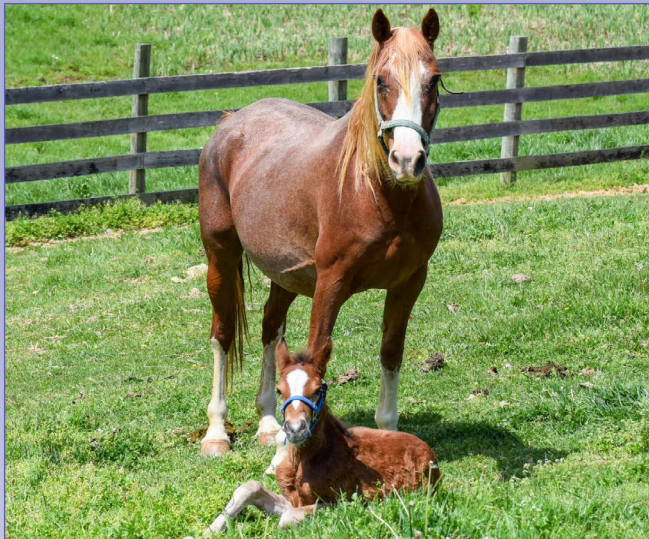

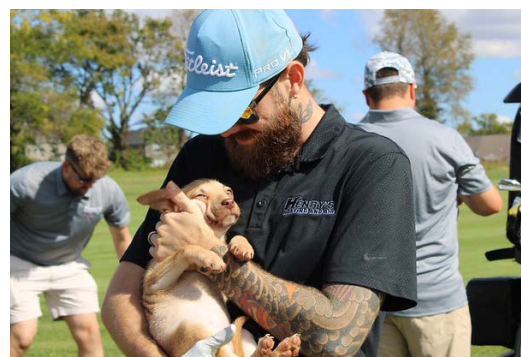

Equine Sponsorship Opportunities

Stall Sponsorship: \$5,000

With a \$5,000 investment, we can refurbish one stall to improve functionality and enhance safety for both animals and handlers. This renovation will improve the animals' well-being, facilitate more positive public engagement by incorporating a new grill-style front, and offer long-term cost savings. The project, completed by our Equine Maintenance Staff over approximately 12 weeks, will also reflect positively on our facility, potentially attracting new supporters.

Equine Assisted Learning

Take a break from the office and join us for experiential learning at the Kentucky Humane Society's Willow Hope Farm in Simpsonville, KY, with an Equine Assisted Learning (EAL) session! EAL offers engaging, group-focused activities with horses designed for team building, leadership development, and group productivity, or simply to foster better connections. Each activity is followed by a debrief to explore how lessons learned apply to other areas of life, with sessions customized to your goals. Set on a working horse farm, home to rescue horses in rehab and training, this inspiring day includes hands-on activities (no riding, and no horse experience required) in a peaceful, scenic setting.

 - Lunch and learn w/tour to meet rescue horses
 - Afternoon session
- **Half-day: \$1,500**
 - Morning session
 - Lunch not included
 - Brief farm tour upon conclusion of session
