### 241 Steedly Drive (Sam Swope Pet TLC/Main Campus)

Team members will help with various projects around this specific campus that benefit the staff AND animals.

Your team could assemble adoption folders, create enrichment items for the animals, clean certain areas of the building, bag food for our Foster Department or many other important tasks that help the shelter!

At this location, we only offer morning shifts and all tasks must be completed by 11:30 a.m., Tuesday through Saturday only. Two to four hour options are available. Your team will have guaranteed puppy and/or kitten interaction! We can accommodate up to 25 people.



# Willow Hope Farm

Kentucky Humane Society Equine C.A.R.E. (Connect, Assist, Rescue, Educate) is a program of the Kentucky Humane Society that is dedicated to helping Kentucky's horses in crisis and horses in transition, preparing them for new careers and homes.

At this location your team will help with various projects/tasks around the farm and barn. A few example tasks would be painting and mending fences, landscaping or cleaning up the stalls and barn area. The farm is more labor intensive due to being outside and the potential for heavy lifting and bending. You are guaranteed to meet our Home Herd horses!

The time options are between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., every day except Sunday, for up to four hour time slots for the months of April through October. We can accommodate up to 25 people.

## Date with a Dog

**241 Steedly Drive (Sam Swope Pet TLC/Main Campus)**

The purpose of the DWAD program is to establish a relaxing and calming outing for our dogs so they can take a much needed break from the shelter.

Team members can split up or go as a larger group. Each group will get one dog to take out of the shelter for a few hours. The dogs cannot mingle with each other, each group will have to stay separate for safety reasons. Up to five dogs can go out at a time. KHS will provide all supplies needed for a great dog date! Pick up times are 8:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m and the dog must be dropped back off by 4:00 p.m.. We provide options Tuesday through Saturday.

Some extra safety requirement for DWAD:

- Do not bring kids under the age of 12, we cannot always guarantee that we will have kid friendly dogs available that day.
- We cannot guarantee certain energy levels for each dog
- Be aware that we might not have small dogs (under 30 pounds) at the shelter on your DWAD dog. Please be prepared for at least a 30 pound dog or more going on a date with you.
- Have your entire group that will participate with the date arrive within a 15 minute time frame of scheduled pick up time. Our staff have a small window of time to get dogs ready for dates and sent out in between cleaning, feeding, play groups and getting ready for opening. Members who show up past the 15 minute mark will not be permitted to take a dog on a date.
